Notes on Application and Election process for a Full Lady Member.

1. Proposer and Seconder

- Each candidate for election as a full member must be proposed and seconded by two full members to whom she is personally known, and who must themselves have been members for at least two years. In cases where this is not possible, the Ladies' Section may, at its sole discretion, act as Proposer/Seconder.
- Members would normally be expected to act as Proposer or Seconder only once in any calendar year. They may, however, write any number of letters of support (see below).
- It is the responsibility of the Proposer and Seconder to ensure that the prospective candidate is a suitable person to become a member of the RCPGC. Either the Proposer or Seconder should endeavour to accompany the candidate to the Club for her interview, in order to facilitate introductions.

2. Documentation

The Proposer is responsible for assembling and processing all documentation on the candidate. The required documents are:

- Application form to be completed by the candidate.
- Proposer/Seconder forms – to be completed separately by the Proposer and Seconder. An accompanying letter to amplify the comments on these forms is highly valuable, and should aim to emphasise the qualities and contribution to the Club that may be expected from the Candidate.
- Any further letters of support would be appreciated, either from other members of the RCPGC or from the Secretary or Captain of another Club of which the candidate is a member.

3. Interview

- The Ladies' Secretary will arrange a mutually convenient date for the candidate to come to the Club to meet and play golf with other members of the Ladies' Committee. Subject to a satisfactory outcome, and to there being a vacancy on the membership list, the candidate's name will then be posted on the notice board for a period of 21 days, to give members an opportunity to make any objection.
- During this period the candidate will be afforded courtesy of the Course in order for her to meet and play with some other members, and seek letters of support from them. Her Proposer and/or Seconder is/are expected to assist in this process by introducing the candidate to other members and helping to arrange games.

4. Election

- If the Ladies' Committee approves the application it will be forwarded to the Board for ratification.
- After election the candidate will become liable to pay the current entrance fee and annual subscription (adjusted pro rata for the time remaining in the Club Year) according to her category of membership. Following this, the applicants membership will be considered to be provisional for a period of a further 12 months. Thereafter membership will be either confirmed or denied.
- The Ladies' Committee may reject any candidate without giving any reason for so doing.

Notes on application and election process for full gentleman members

1. Proposer and Secunder

- Each candidate for election as a full member must be proposed and seconded by two full members to whom he is personally known, and who must themselves have been members for at least two years. In cases where this is not possible, the RCP Board may, at its sole discretion, act as Proposer/Secunder.
- Members would normally be expected to act as a Proposer or Secunder only once in any calendar year. They may, however, write any number of letters of support (see below).
- It is the responsibility of the Proposer and Secunder to ensure that the prospective candidate is a suitable person to become a member of the Royal Cinque Ports Golf Club. They must be satisfied that the standard of his golf is such that he will not inconvenience other players on the links; that he will be fully capable of playing in Club competitions; and that he will conduct himself appropriately at all times when on the Club premises or on the links. Either the Proposer or Secunder should endeavour to accompany the candidate to the Club for his interview, in order to facilitate introductions.

2. Documentation

The Proposer is responsible for assembling and processing of all documentation on the candidate. The required documents are:

- Application Form and CV – to be completed by the candidate.
- Proposer/Secunder forms – to be completed separately by the Proposer and Secunder. An accompanying letter to amplify the comments on these forms is highly valuable, and should aim to emphasise the qualities and contribution to the Club that may be expected from the candidate.
- Three letters of support from current full members who have played golf with the candidate.

3. Interview

- The Secretary or Director responsible for membership will arrange a mutually convenient date for the candidate to come to the Club to meet them and play golf. The Captain and other Board members may also be present. It is highly desirable that the candidate's Proposer and Secunder should attend in order to facilitate introductions. Subject to a satisfactory outcome and to there being a vacancy on the membership list, the candidate's name will then be posted on the notice board for a period of 21 days to give members an opportunity to make any objection.
- During this period the candidate will be afforded courtesy of the Course, in order for him to meet and play golf with other members and seek letters of support from them. His Proposer and/or Secunder is expected to assist in this process by introducing the candidate to other members and helping to arrange games.

4. Election

- The Secretary and/or Director responsible for membership will present applications for consideration at the next scheduled meeting of the RCP Board following the 21-day period. If no objections have been raised and the Board's decision is positive, the candidate's application will be approved, subject to the election being considered provisional for a period of 12 months. Thereafter, membership will either be confirmed or denied. The Board may reject any candidate without giving any reason for so doing.
- After election, the candidate will become liable to pay the current entrance fee and annual subscription (adjusted *pro rata* for the time remaining in the Club year), according to his category of membership.
